

# The Project – RA250



## **The Brief**

Working with the Royal Academy of Art for over 12 years, we were invited to support them in their 'RA-250' project, working with developers and architects in the modernisation of the buildings ready to celebrate their 250<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. This involved new cat 6 and fibre infrastructure to the clients Art stores covering CCTV, Door Access, Data and Fibre

## **The Proposal**

We worked closely with the client's architects and main contractors from the initial drawing stage to ensure a perfect network infrastructure running throughout that would service the required installation, offering flexibility and growth when and where required.

## **The Technology**

Taking the opportunity to improve upon the existing infrastructure, but also aware of the listed status of the building recommended Cat6 LSOH Copper Cable and OM4 Multimode Fibre.

## **The Installation**

Working with the main contractor we ensured the containment met with the Clients requirements and complied with the latest BICSI regulations.

## **The Challenges**

Given the 'Listed' status of the building and the 'End Use' we were particularly aware of the aesthetic look of the installation ensuring that it blended discreetly with its surroundings.

## **The Follow Up**

Upon completion, full Test Results and Marked up drawings of cable runs and outlets are produced and provided to the client.
